

Trail Rules and Safety Tips


1. No trail pass is required, the trails are free for all to use. Donations are welcome.
2. All trails may be used by skiers. Fat tire bikes and snow shoes may only use designated trails. ALL users must follow appropriate trail etiquette. (See inside of brochure)
3. Most trails are listed for intermediate to advanced skill levels. Please stay within your ability level and use caution at all times when on the trails.
4. For your safety, most trails are one-way use. Observe the directions indicated on the trail map and signs.
5. Users must stay on designated trails to avoid damage to greens and tees on the golf course. Contact with wildlife is prohibited.
6. Dogs, horses, snowboards, snowmobiles, motor vehicles, and alcohol are prohibited. Walking on the trails is also prohibited.
7. Ski trail conditions can change rapidly throughout the day. Trails that are heavily used can be completely destroyed, even if groomed earlier in the day.

Trail Etiquette

Our designated ski trails are groomed for both classic and skate style skiing. Fat tire bikes and snow shoes may use the designated trails as long as they stay to the right of the trails. All users, please move to the right to allow faster users to pass.

Grooming Protocol

1. Trails are groomed every Monday and Friday, conditions permitting. It generally requires a minimum of 4" of snow to set a track for classic diagonal skiing.
2. Grooming for skating can be done with as little as 2" of snow, depending on whether or not a base has been established.
3. Classic diagonal stride trails are also available at Lakeview Park (1/3 mile loop)
4. Fat tire bike/Snow shoe trails are not groomed.

★	Trailhead, Parking, and Restroom	HOW TO USE THE TRAILS SKATING CLASSICAL FAT TIRES/SNOWSHOE
Beginner		
Red	0.6 mi - One way direction of travel	Snowshoes and Fat Tire Bikes are not allowed on the groomed track areas. Please stay to the edge of the trails. ALL USERS MUST STAY ON DESIGNATED TRAILS AT ALL TIMES
Intermediate		
Orange	1.2 mi - One way direction of travel	
Yellow	0.7 mi - One way direction of travel	
White	3.0 mi - One way direction of travel	
Blue	1.6 mi - Two way traffic is allowed. Fat tire bike/Snowshoe allowed	
Advanced		
Green	0.7 mi - One way direction of travel	
Black	0.3 mi - Two way traffic is allowed. Fat tire bike/Snowshoe allowed	
Purple	Two way traffic is allowed. Fat tire bike and Snowshoe ONLY
