Closing Early Policy

Inclement Weather- If the air temperature is less than 60 degrees, it is driving raining or lightning, the Aquatic Center will be closed.

Lack of Attendance- During the course of the season, the lack of attendance at the Aquatic Center may cause the closing of the Center. If we have 20 people or less for 2 hours, the WBAC may close early.

Walter R. Bauman Swim Lessons

Resident \$40/session
Non-Resident \$60/session

Level 1 - This level is an introduction to water skills focusing on helping participants feel comfortable in the water.

Level 2 - This level focuses on learning and improving fundamental aquatic skills. It gives participants practice with basic water activities.

Level 3 - This level focuses on stroke development as well as practice swimming in deeper water.

Level 4 - This level focuses on developing confidence in the skills learned and improves other aquatic skills.

Level 5 - This level is for stroke refinement and providing further coordination and improvement of strokes.

Level 6 - Refines the strokes so participants swim them with ease, efficiency, power and smoothness over greater distances. This level focuses on preparing participants for more advanced courses.

Ages: 6 months-3 years old: Parent/Child classes
3-4 years old: Levels I "P", II "P"
5 years and up: Levels I-VI

Our "P" level classes are specifically designed for students 3-4 years old. Children must be able to be in the water comfortably, without a parent, and be ready to comprehend & follow instructions.
