

Jurisdictional Boundaries
City of Middleton
Comprehensive Plan



- City to follow planned land uses on Town's Future Land Use Map
 - Town to follow planned land uses in its comprehensive plan
 - Town may amend its plan if consistent with Town goals
 - 3-mile jurisdiction limited on western side of Town

- City and Town to follow planned land uses from Future Land Use Map
 - City or Town may amend land use plans if other agrees
 - No annexations or service area extensions within 20 years (as of 2003)

- Same Conditions apply as in Long-Term Preservation Area, although growth beyond 20 years (as of 2003) may occur.

- Town to follow Agricultural Preservation District policies
 - City to consult with Town and residents on detailed plans
 - City may annex land based on land owner requests
 - Future growth mainly residential, with tech uses near Highway 12
